# **YOUTH PARADE RULES & REGULATIONS**

***JUDGING is an on-going process and WILL TAKE PLACE BETWEEN 9-10 am***  
***(The Best Elementary Award, Bands & Drill Teams will be judged along the route)***

**LINE-UP PROCEDURE:** You will be notified of your line-up number prior to parade day.

A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE for General Liability (bodily injury and property damage) &/OR Automobile Liability (if vehicle is in your entry) with limits of \$500,000 is required of HORSE/LARGE ANIMAL ENTRIES AND BAND & DRILL TEAM ENTRIES! The Washington State Apple Blossom Festival and City of Wenatchee must be named as ADDITIONAL INSURED. If there is a MOTORIZED VEHICLE in your entry, you must submit an Insurance Policy Declaration from the OWNER of the vehicle. Certificates of Insurance may be faxed from your Insurance Company or Agent (please write entry name on fax) to 509-665-0347. Must be received by April 1, 2010.

## **GENERAL RULES AND SAFETY REGULATIONS FOR ALL ENTRIES:**

1. **PARADE APPLICATIONS MUST BE RETURNED WITH CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE ATTACHED, AND THE RELEASE & WAIVER OF LIABILITY FORM SIGNED. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**
2. The festival needs ONLY 1 Release & Waiver of Liability form signed by the contact person or group leader. The contact person must make copies of the form to have a parent or guardian of each parade participant sign, which the group leader keeps on hand. An adult (18 years or older) must accompany each entry.
3. Entries must observe all applicable rules/regulations and follow all instructions from police or parade officials; or be barred from the parade. The Festival Association and Parade Committee reserve the right to remove any entrant, in whole or part, from the parade, if any part of the entry does not meet Festival rules/regulations, or conform to the standards of reasonable public taste either prior to, or during the parade.
4. Water is not permitted by participants to be **used** on spectators anytime during the parade.
5. **DISTRIBUTION OF MERCHANDISE, LITERATURE, CANDY, OR OTHER MATERIAL ALONG PARADE ROUTE IS PROHIBITED.**
6. Entries advocating, opposing, or depicting any political, religious, or social issues are subject to approval of the parade committee.
7. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any entry, in any vehicle, or on the person of any participant prior to or during the parade.
8. Anyone riding bikes in the parade is required to wear a helmet.
9. All corporate logos/Business Names visible on entries must be pre-approved by the Youth Parade committee, i.e. Pepsi Cola is the Official Beverage of the Washington State Apple Blossom Festival - no other beverage/logo will be allowed in or on any Youth Parade entry.
12. ***GO CARTS, SKATEBOARDS, ROLLER-SKATES, IN-LINE SKATES, MOTORIZED BIKES, GARDEN TRACTORS, RIDING LAWNMOWERS, BATTERY OPERATED UNITS, OR O.R.V.'S must be controlled by a properly licensed adult driver.***
13. **NO WEAPONS, REAL OR PRETEND, WILL BE ALLOWED! INCLUDES TOY GUNS, SQUIRT GUNS, BOWS & ARROWS, ETC.**
14. **ONLY ROYALTY FROM THE WENATCHEE VALLEY OR REPRESENTING WASHINGTON STATE IN THEIR TITLE ARE ELIGIBLE.**
15. **NO DIESEL-ENGINE BUSES**
16. The Youth Parade has the same dress code as established for public schools - please wear appropriate-styled outfits/dance uniforms.
17. Entries must predominantly have kids under the age of 14 present, unless special approval by the parade committee.

## **ADDITIONAL PET/HORSE/LARGE ANIMAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

1. All pets must be on a leash/lead and under control at all times. To ensure your pet's comfort, we suggest you provide water.
2. HORSE/LARGE ANIMAL ENTRIES:
  - a. Must provide own insurance (see requirements above).
  - b. Must provide own clean-up crew.
  - c. **NO Stallions** - Only neutered male large animals are allowed.
  - d. Any participant showing inability to control their animal (in the Parade Officials' opinion) will be considered unsafe and will be removed from the Youth Parade.

## **ADDITIONAL FLOAT/MECHANICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Entries must furnish drivers for their floats. Drivers must be at least 21 years of age with a valid driver's license carried during the parade.
2. All participants on motorized floats that are standing, must be wearing a safety belt, have handholds, or be in a slide-in body support while the float is moving. Floats that do not have safety belts or handholds will not be allowed in the parade. SAFETY BELT MUST BE WORN VISIBLY ON OUTSIDE OF GARMENTS. All seated participants must be seated at all times & have a substantial barrier in front of them.
3. Must provide insurance (see requirements above).

## **ADDITIONAL BAND AND DRILL TEAM REQUIREMENTS:**

1. All marching units **MUST** maintain a forward motion & cadences must be at least 120 beats per minute. Routines are encouraged, but please try to limit the gaps it may cause.
2. Judging will be done within the second block from the starting point. Trophies will be awarded in three divisions. Names of winning bands will be available the Wednesday following the Youth Parade. Trophies will be mailed to winning bands from outside the Wenatchee Area.
3. School mascots need to be in vehicles or must have own security walking down the route.
4. Must provide insurance (see requirements above).
